What is a CTF? CTF, or Capture The Flag, is a type of cybersecurity competition that challenges people to solve a variety of problems from cracking a cryptography scheme to reverse engineering a vulnerable program. This particular competition is designed with beginners in mind, so (most) challenges will be entirely feasible, even with no experience!

This event will be held October 19th 2021 during the 109th annual Engineer's Day at UTK. It is available to all visiting highschool students and is entirely free. Details for registering will be available closer to the event in our discord (invite below). Also, exact start and end times will be made available later. Prizes are TBD.

Violation of anything listed below here or deemed worthy by an organizer may result in point deductions or disqualifications.

Students may compete in teams of 1-4 during the competition. Cooperation between teams is prohibited. Furthermore, you are not allowed to switch teams once the event begins, and you can only be on a single team. Completed challenges will net points for competing teams. By the end of the event, the team with the most points is the winner.

You are not allowed to hack/cheat the website hosting the challenges (e.g., bruteforcing flags) or deny service to other participants. You may not sabotage other competitors in any way (e.g., deleting flags or breaking services). Use of the Internet to solve challenges is allowed, but do not attempt to find similar problems & solutions online. Be respectful to organizers and competitors, don't troll or spam.

These rules and regulations may be subject to change at any time (including during the event).
