

Penny Boat Challenge Rules and Regulations

- Work individually or in groups of 2-3
- Each will be given a square of aluminum foil
- Groups/Individuals are to construct a boat out of the foil to hold as many pennies as possible without sinking
- Pennies will be counted by an Engineering Outreach Ambassador team member to ensure correct scores
- Scores will be recorded, along with the winners so the schools can be notified
- More than one boat may be tested at a time
- Interfering with other boats is not allowed
- Combining groups/individuals allotted aluminum foil is not allowed
- Scores are based on the number of pennies a boat held
- The penny that sinks the boat is not counted
- Only one penny may be added to the boat at a time
